# **Capital Project Coordination Savings Estimates**

Enabling "Dig Once" Project Planning and estimate amount in construction savings that could be enabled over the next 5 years as a result of better coordination of Capital Improvement Project Plans through GIS. Planning and capital improvement data management needed across City of Raleigh Divisions - Public Works (Road, Sidewalks), Public Utilities (Sewer, Water), Stormwater, and Network Infrastructure (Fiber) - as well as third party organizations such as Electric Utilities, Cable and Internet Companies.

# Water Customer Retrofit Analysis

Identify and target customers who would benefit most from water efficiency (saving) retrofit technologies by segmenting the customer accounts by features, such as Customer Type (Residential, Commercial, Owner vs. Rent), Water Usage and Age of Properties (Wake County Property data).

## Multi-Modal Network Gap Analysis

Demand and gap analysis for multi-modal transit options for current and planned infrastructure (Dedicated Bike Lanes, Greenways, Bus Routes. Bike Share). What % of people within areas of high density and target demographic profiles have a transit + walking (< 0.3 miles) or biking pathway (< 5 mi first/last mile) to known job / POI areas.

# Stormwater Water Quality Index

Creation of a meaningful water quality scoring method and index for streams managed by COR stormwater division, using volunteer and staff collected stream quality data, in order to compare and prioritize action.

# Traffic Congestion and Real-Time Optimization Analysis

Using traffic camera and Waze application data to optimize light timing models, reduce congestion and increase travel efficiency. This analysis would involve using Waze traffic jam data to detect congestion patterns to prioritize further study, and then image analysis from congested corridor with Traffic Cameras to count or detect demand at lights at different times of day. The real time counts would be used to recommend new Signal timing model software to do real-time analysis of demand and throughput during green lights to suggest.

# Next Generation Planning using 3D Models

Support 3D Model Development and Maintenance. Using a multitude of data sources including: state and city sponsored LiDAR programs; leveraging UAV with onboard sensors (including LiDAR). (Perhaps leveraging Drones from NGAT)
