What is Grants.gov?

Grants.gov is an electronic portal that allows users to find, apply, and manage federal grant opportunities. Grants.gov simplifies the grants management process and creates a centralized, online process to find application forms, and apply for, over 900 grant programs from the 26 Federal grant-making agencies.



How soon must I use Grants.gov?

Many federal grant-making agencies require grant submission via Grants.gov. NIH will soon require all competing research grant applications to be submitted electronically via the web portal of Grants.gov on a new SF 424 Research and Related (R&R) application.

2. Be ready to generate PDF documents
3. Attend a training session or review online instructional Materials
4. Consult with your College Research Office

The 5 Steps for Submitting Proposals via Grants.gov:

1. Download the Application Package via Grants.gov
2. Complete the Application Package
3. Always use sps@ncsu.edu and correct mailing address and phone numbers
4. Send the Application Package to College (via PINS record)
5. Verify the Application Package via eRA Commons [NIH Only]
